

University Council for Workforce and Human Resource Education What is the Meritorious Service Award?

The University Council for Workforce and Human Resource Education is an organization composed of eighteen major universities that provide research, service, teacher education, and advance graduate studies in career and technical education and human resource development. The Council's activities are accomplished through the cooperative efforts of the member universities by contributing human and material resources to inter-institutional projects that exceed the scope and capabilities of any one university. The University Council Meritorious Service Award addresses a need to recognize one faculty member from a member institution for service to the profession and to the Council.

Each year the trustees of the Council will choose a person to receive the Meritorious Service

Award. The individual selected will receive a plaque.

Criteria and Selection Procedure

The Meritorious Service Award will be selected by the trustees of the University Council for Workforce and Human Resource Education using the following criteria:

1. The contribution of the faculty member's work is making in the broad field of workforce and career and technical education.
2. The importance of the work to the improvement of workforce and career and technical education.
3. The quality of the faculty member's work with respect to instruction, service, and/or research in this field.
4. Evidence that the faculty member has made a contribution to the programs of the Council.

Nomination must be postmarked no later than May 20, 2009 to be accepted for consideration. The UCWHRE Trustees will make the final selection.
